Schools 'Water' initiatives:

Water can be saved in many ways. Leftover water from pupils' water bottles is used to water the vegetable garden at All Saints' Primary School.

Pannal School installed 'push taps' and reduced water consumption by 17%.

Starbeck Community Primary and Nursery School created a playground trim trail, seating area and flowerbeds. They installed a water butt connected to the shed roof to collect water for use in the garden.

Boroughbridge High School successfully reduced their water use, by investing in new urinals.
