Business 'Transport' ideas:

Bramall & Jones is a car leasing company which has made links with Climate Care, an organisation that will try and offset carbon dioxide emissions by investing in renewable energy and energy efficiency projects in third world companies. Emissions from company cars are offset in this way, and customers who choose to do so can benefit from the scheme too.

At Goosemoor Organics green travel to work is encouraged, with a green travel bonus of £1.50 a day given to any staff that don't require a car parking space.

The type of fuel, vehicle efficiency and the nature of delivery routes can all affect the environmental impact of transport.

Goosemoor Organics' entire delivery fleet runs on environmentally friendly biodiesel (made from vegetable fat) and LPG, which has significantly reduced harmful transport emissions. To encourage alternative transport, staff are offered a 'green travel bonus' if they do not need a parking place.

Cartridge World use a high efficiency Smart car for deliveries, and *Jespers* closely monitors and fine-tunes delivery rounds to reduce mileage. Both these measures cut pollution and costs.



The Green House purchases as much produce as possible from suppliers within a 20-mile distance from the shop, to cut down pollution and energy costs
