

Appendix IV Buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest in Harrogate District

(N.B. THIS APPENDIX IS PROVIDED FOR INFORMATION ONLY)

Note: All items are Grade II unless otherwise stated i.e. an * denotes a Grade II* listing, and a (I) denotes a Grade I listing. Each separate entry in the list has, as far as possible, been specifically identified and is terminated by a semi-colon (;). However, in a few cases, entries covering groups of buildings or features have been combined to avoid repetition and these are indicated in italics, e.g. "*Barns and byre ranges*". The titles of many listings have been abbreviated.

Where barns, outbuildings, walls, etc. are not otherwise identified, they relate to the named building immediately preceding. For example, "Brimham Lodge (I); Front gates and garden walls; Sundial and mounting block; Outbuilding; [next named building]" means that Brimham Lodge is listed Grade I and that there are three other separate entries in the list which relate to it.

In case of doubt, the advice of the Borough Council's Conservation & Design staff should be sought.

Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the following summary at the date of completion (Feb 2001), but it has no legal status. The inadvertent omission, change of name or incorrect address of any building should not be taken as conclusive evidence that it is not listed. The Secretary of State for National Heritage may list further buildings from time to time.
