ADOPTION OF THE HARROGATE DISTRICT CORE STRATEGY DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT (DPD): 11 FEBRUARY 2009

In accordance with Regulation 36 (Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004) this statement is to inform you that Harrogate Borough Council formally adopted its Core Strategy DPD on 11 February 2009. The Core Strategy forms part of the Harrogate District Local Development Framework (LDF) and sets out broad policies for the development and conservation of the District up to 2023. Other DPDs being produced such as the Site Allocations (Homes and Jobs) DPD and Development Control Policies DPD will need to be in accordance with the vision, objectives and policies of the Core Strategy.
