NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Harrogate, propose to amend the byelaws made under the Stray Act 1985, the effect of which will be to permit the joint pedestrian and cycle use of the footpaths identified on the attached plan. The Council proposes to widen where necessary the footpaths affected to accommodate the joint use, details of the footpaths to be widened can be viewed on the Council's website www.harrogate.gov.uk

The Council wishes to hear your views on the proposal to permit cycling on the Stray footpaths and these should be sent in writing to the Head of Parks and Open Spaces at the address given below by 1 June 2010.
