CASTLES, HISTORIC BUILDINGS ETC

FOUNTAINS ABBEY AND STUDLEY ROYAL. (National Trust) Ripon HG4 3DY.

Description:	The Fountains Abbey and Studley Royal Estate includes the most complete Cistercian remains of an Abbey in Britain. 18th Century landscaped garden, 17th Century Hall, Victorian Church and one of the best monastic mills in Europe.
Open:	<p>Times apply to the Estate -</p> <p>1st March – 31st October 10.00 – 17.00</p> <p>1st November – 31st Jan '09 10.00 - 16.00</p> <p>1st February - 29th February '09 10.00 – 16.00</p> <p>Deer Park – Free. Access	<p>Car park is approx. 100 to 200 yards from the entrance. There is a ramp wherever necessary. There are steps but there are alternative routes for visitors with disabilities. There is always a member of staff ready to assist at all points.</p> <p><u>Visitor Centre (Main Entrance):</u> Some distance from ruins etc. with good surfaces on pathways but with some inclines. Wheelchair accessible minibus runs a ferry service to the Valley floor. 3 Batricars and several wheelchairs are available by prior arrangement on 01765 608888</p> <p><u>West (Fountains Hall) Entrance:</u> Adjacent car park restricted to disabled visitors. Batricars available from here by prior arrangement.</p> <p><u>Studley Royal Entrance:</u> Car park is approx. 50 yards from the entrance with a slope, although disabled visitors can be set down at the entrance. There are two wheelchairs available by prior arrangement. There are disabled accessible toilets in Studley car park, the west gate, Studley tearoom and the Visitor Centre*. There aren't really any restrictions although they do strongly advise owners of 3-wheeled vehicles that they are not suitable on the estates terrain, however their 4-wheeled Batricars are available by prior arrangements.</p> <p>*Opening times vary, check at property.</p>

Description:	Historic country house, the lived in home of the Compton family. Delightful example of Robert Adam interior decoration and Chippendale furniture. 18th Century Gobelins Tapestries and Gallery of Classical Statuary. Award winning gardens, good wheelchair access. Miniature Railway, children's adventure garden, restaurant and picnic area. NEW FOR 2008 'Tarantella' dancing water play feature by William Pye.
Open:	No winter opening unless by prior arrangement. Opening Times 2008 21st March - 28th September Tuesdays to Sundays, plus Bank Holidays and Mondays in July and August Garden: 11:00 – 17:00 House: 12:00 – 17:00 Sculpture Park opens 1st June
Access	The disabled car park is approx. 20 yards from the entrance. There are shallow steps into the house, the ground floor is accessible but there is no lift to the upper floors. There is a ramp into the gardens and a ramp into the restaurant. There are five wheelchairs available on free loan. The miniature railway has a carriage for a disabled visitor. There is also a free garden route map for wheelchair users. The wheelchair accessible toilets adjoin the restaurant and are also in the main car park. There are 2 motorised and 4 manual wheelchairs available, free of charge. However, it is advisable to reserve one in advance.

Description: Ripley Castle stands at the heart of the delightful estate village of Ripley, with lakes, deer park and Victoria walled gardens. The Ingilby family have lived in the castle for 26 generations and there are wonderful stories to be told about the trials and tribulations of the Ingilby family throughout English history.

Access	There is reserved parking close to the entrance. There are good paths around most parts of the gardens but distances and some gradients are involved. Three manual and two electric wheelchairs available (pre-booking is recommended). There are unisex toilets in the entrance of the building. Only guide and registered support dogs are allowed into the garden.

Description:	The Mercer Art Gallery is home to the District's superb collection of Art. Originally built in 1806 as Harrogate's first spa building, 'The Promenade Room' has been restored to its former glory. The Gallery hosts a diverse programme of events and exhibitions, ranging from national touring exhibitions of painting, photography, sculpture and crafts to the display of work by local artists. Also home to the Kent Bequest - a fine archaeological collection that includes Egyptian and Greek artefacts.

Access:	There is full disabled access. There is on street parking on Swan Road. There is also a ramp at the back entrance where there is a bell and a member of staff will open the double doors. There are also wheelchair accessible toilets.

Description:	Conference, Exhibition and Concert Venue
Access:	The car park has 15 car park spaces for blue badge holders, unlimited time at no cost. It is also within easy access of the lift, which gives direct access to all facilities. There are seven wheelchair spaces in the Auditorium, Block H coloured orange on the auditorium plan. In the event of an emergency evacuation a trained usher will help you evacuate the building safely. Both lifts comply with fire regulations and are for the exclusive use of wheelchair users. They can be used by two people and their carer at any one time. A third wheelchair user can wait with their carer, in Safe Holding Area near the lift until it returns. The Auditorium and all payphones in the centre are fitted with induction loops (Switch hearing aid to position T). If you intend to bring a guide dog please inform them so that they can provide your dogs with refreshments. Toilets for disabled visitors are located on the lower foyer (Level 4) and upper foyer (Level 5).

Access:	<p>The theatre has four specially allocated spaces for wheelchair users in the main auditorium. Companion seats are available next to these spaces. Parking spaces for disabled permit holders are on Cheltenham Parade at the rear of the Theatre. There are fully accessible toilets in the Stalls area. The main auditorium is fitted with an induction loop. For digital users lanyards are available. Sign Language Interpreted Performances in BSL, generously supported by A&S Burton 1960 Charitable Trust are available for selected Harrogate Theatre productions. Also Stagertext Captioning (similar to TV subtitles)</p> <p>When booking please let the Box Office staff know you require a wheelchair seat or will be watching the signer.</p>

Access:	<p>The car park is approx. 5 yards from the entrance. There is an automatic door and dropped kerb. The door is approx 1.8m wide and there is a bell to ring for assistance. Level access to the box office and to screens 3 and 4 (5 with lift). Disabled toilet with bell in Foyer. Wheelchairs accommodated but safety regulations impose limitations upon the number which can be permitted. There are hearing aid induction loops available in all screens, box office and kiosk.</p>

Access:	Car park approx 50 yards from the main centre. Car park is on the same level as the entrance. There are disabled accessible toilets available, the café is also suitable for visitors with disabilities. The miniature railway has a carriage accessible for wheelchair users. It is possible to access most rides and attractions. To go on the 'Ultimate' and 'Fall of Terror' you do need to be able to access the stairways and have the ability to evacuate the ride if necessary. Assistance Dogs are allowed into the theme park.

Description: Historic estate with woodland and riverside walks for all ages and disabilities. Medieval buildings include Bolton Priory overlooking the river Wharfe. Riverside picnic sites and Cavendish Pavilion Café at entrance to Strid wood.

Open: All year.

Access: Parking in Bolton Abbey village car park (on left of B6160 of Bolton Abbey/Grassington Road) and Sandholme (Cavendish Pavilion) car park (which is on right of B6160).

There are five electric wheelchairs available at village and Sandholme car parks from mid March to the end of October.

From Bolton Abbey car park first entrance (via gateway in wall) involves some steep steps.

The second entry (a little further along the B6160) allows relatively level access to Priory Church.

Strid Wood Nature Trail mainly wheelchair accessible from Cavendish Pavilion but assistance would probably be required. Ramp to Cavendish Pavilion restaurant (open daily from mid March to end of October, Tuesday-Sunday in winter).

There is a ramp to the entrance, also a stair lift and then two shallow steps into the house. All the rooms are wheelchair accessible but the terrace would be problematical. The bird garden involves gradients, which would require strong assistance for wheelchair users. New facility-Golf buggy from gates to house. Wheelchairs are available at the house and bird garden. There are unisex toilets near the main car park.

There is level access to the ground floor but this is on 2 levels, involving 3 steps. The grounds are mainly accessible to wheelchairs but on gravelled paths, there is also access to Stables Café. Wheelchair accessible toilets are also located in the Stable Block.

Access:	Free reserved space in car park allocated to disabled visitors which are next to the city entrance. There are automatic doors, ramps, lifts and a chair lift provide access to the museum. Wheelchairs are available for free loans at entrances. Guide dogs and hearing dogs welcome. There are unisex toilets in Great Hall and Station Hall. There are also baby changing facilities in all toilets. Some of the collection is viewed from walkways which are not accessible to wheelchair users at the moment.

Description: Britain's prestigious national collection of arms and armour, with galleries which have themes on War, Tournament, The Orientals, Self Defence and Hunting. Allow at least four hours for your visit.

Open: 10.00 - 17.00 All Year Round
Closed: 24 & 25 December
For Spring 2008 the Museum will close at 15.00 daily until Good Friday for restoration work.

Access: There is free parking for blue badge holders in bays, which are close to the museum. A number of wheelchairs are available to borrow for the whole day. Access is available throughout the museum with the exception of the Yorkshire Electricity Hall of Steel. The information desk has a low level counter and a loop system. All lifts are accessible to wheelchair users. Guests are advised to arrive in good time for good views of cinema and Tiltyard performances. For visitors with a hearing impairment they may not be able to hear the live interpretations and there are also no subtitles on the monitors. There are wheelchair accessible toilet facilities available throughout the museum.

Description: From the ordeal of surgery before anaesthetics to the discovery of modern medicine, the museum's large collection of objects has things to amaze, amuse and shock you. Allow 2½ - 3 hours for your visit.

Closed: 24-26 December, 31 December & 1 January
Open every day during school holidays.

Access: The museum has a car park with spaces reserved for blue badge holders and is next to the entrance to the museum. There is a dropped kerb and the approach to the museum is level. The museum exhibitions are spread over 2,500m² on two floors. There is a lift to all floors and seating throughout the galleries. All areas of the museum and almost all the exhibits are accessible to wheelchair users. Space for wheelchair users can be reserved in the conference centre auditorium. Induction loops are fitted throughout the galleries and in the conference centre auditorium. Written text versions of all sounds within the displays are available. Many areas of the museum contain objects, displays and inter-actives which can be touched and there are many exhibits which include sound. 'Walkman' audio guide of ground floor galleries. Please telephone to ensure availability. Two wheelchairs are available on request, please telephone to book. Normal admission charges apply, but essential carers are admitted free of charge. Please also telephone in advance if you have any special dietary requirements for the café and catering. Fully accessible toilets are located on the ground floor next to the lift, and on the first floor in the entrance to the conference centre. There are steps down to the baby change area.

BLUE BADGE PARKING

Where to Park in Harrogate District

Any of the Council's off-street car parks. Parking is free of charge and for an unrestricted length of time. Some of the car parks have spaces designated for disabled badge holders. Any parking place on-street (apart from the exemptions listed below). Parking is free of charge and for an unrestricted length of time. On single or double yellow lines (apart from where a loading/unloading restriction exists) for a maximum period of three hours, providing that your vehicle does not cause obstruction to other traffic or pedestrians.

Where not to park in Harrogate District

Where loading or unloading restriction is in operation. Taxi ranks, loading bays, bus stops, cycle lanes, pedestrian crossings, clearways or School 'Keep Clear' markings. Where temporary restrictions on parking are in force along a length of road, e.g. as indicated by no-waiting cones. Where it would be obstructive or cause a danger to others, e.g. at school entrances, close to a junction, narrow stretches of road, blocking vehicle entrances, emergency vehicle entrances, pavements.
