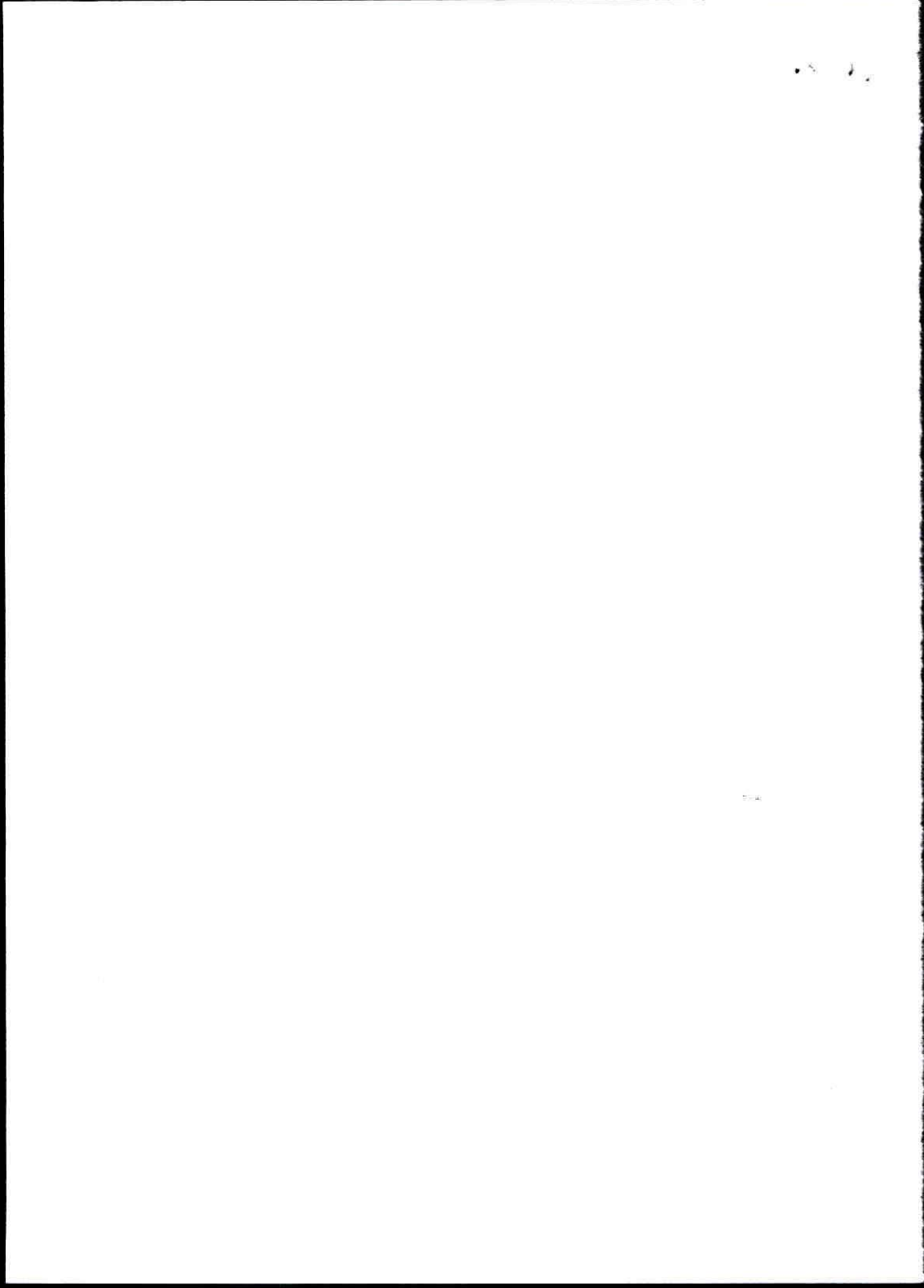

I write as a long time resident (50 yrs) expressing my dismay, yet again, at the proposal to inflict this lovely area with something that will undoubtedly bring noise, pollution, and likely inconvenience (rather than the opposite!) to those of us living in Kirby Hill - or in property scattered around the village proper.

It fills me with alarm.

I see no reason for its existence



on what is prime agricultural land, - and in such close proximity to a population who have chosen to live in this village, with the facilities of an attractive little town nearby - and what it cannot provide being available a few miles away.

I can only see the proposed M.S.A. as an intrusion on the landscape 24 hours a day - the visual impact by day - and night unacceptable.

The obvious increase in traffic - and especially iteV's is likely to present problems in the area - more noise, more pollution and more congestion on surrounding roads - with the accompanying safety hazards / problems.
